<b>Variety Name</b>	<b>Colour</b>	<b>Description</b>
Albert Schweitzer	Pink	Vigorous growth habit with large leaves.
Bergs Yellow	Yellow	Compact habit. Good yellow flower.
Bernstein	Yellow	Bernstein is German for amber, this describes the colour well. The foliage is long and quite attractive.
Black Magic	Red	Good, solid grower with waxy foliage. Deep red flower.
Brown Eyes	Pink	Rose pink flowers with strong brown spotting. Large, glossy deep green leaves with prominent veins. Very hardy.
Cary Ann	Pink	Coral pink/red flowers. Steady growing shrub. Hardy anywhere in the British Isles.
Catawbiense Alba	White	A vigorous but shapely grower with glossy convex leaves. Sun, heat and wind tolerant. Very hardy.
Catawbiense Grandiflora	Mauve	Long lasting lilac flowers. Slightly glossy, smooth dark foliage. Very hardy.
Cosmopolitan	Pink	Attractive flowers, fairly freely produced, some buds may open in the Autumn.
Cunningham White	White	Sturdy plant with small white flowers enhanced by green/yellow blotches. Hardy -10 to -15.
Goldflimmer	Mauve	One of very few variegated clones. Leaves variegated with flecks and splashes of yellow internally.
Holden	Red	Hardy and compact glossy leaves.
Madame Masson	White	Relatively large conical trusses of star shaped flowers, with a bold yellow blotch. A dense, spreading grower.
Mayor Johnson	Red	Large bell shaped flowers. Matt-green foliage. Compact bushy growing habit.
Molten Gold	Purple	Rich gold variegation and flowers purple. The growth habit is compact.
Nova Zembla	Red	Ideal for severe climates. Deep-green healthy leaves on a sturdy upright grower.
Ponticum Variegata	Purple	Leaves have striking, creamy white variegation along the edges. Strong growth habit.
Roseum Elegans	Pink	Vigorous upright plant with large, dark glossy leaves.
